> The first order of business, to organize the Council, in order named:

> Lynn Cooke was chosen chairman of the Town Council. Samuel C. Wilson was chosen Councilman of the Town Council. W. E. Johnson was chosen Councilman of the Town Council. Orson Black was chosen Councilman of the Town Council. Fred Jessop was chosen Clerk & Councilman of the Town Council.

All voted unanimously to sustain the above organization.

ELECTION:

Discussion held on plan for elections: It was agreed to have the Chairman be the outgoing man each year and others to serve as Chairman the last year of their consecutive tenure. One new member to be elected each year, the Council to be empowered to appoint or hire a manager to conduct business for the Council.

J. R. Williams was elected Justice of the Peace by unanimous acclamation. Vergel Y. Jessop was elected Town Marshall by unanimous acclamation.

It was the consensus of opinion that we should appoint a regular monthly meeting and that we should go forward in serious spirit to do our official business.

Subjects of street, water, and traffic were under discussion. Proposed map of land and streets was presented by Fred Jessop
